Help

Before you can organize and print your titlesheets, you will need to create a new unit with Discware Online that corresponds with your new Discgear storage unit.

First, enter the **Storage Unit Name**, which can be anything that helps you remember it's contents.

For example, **My Music**, or **My Software**.

Then you will select the **Storage Unit Label**, which is used to help distinguish one storage unit from another. You may change the letter or leave the default.

Next, select your storage unit. Please use the Selector equivalent for your ROMdex storage unit. For example, choose the Selector 80H if you have a ROMdex 80 w/ a handle.

To finish, click **add**.

On the next page, you will be able to enter your discs' information. The way we intended the units to be used is as follows. Let's say for example you have a Selector 100. You should start with slot 1, and place any CD in any order inside. You will also then enter the title of that CD into Discware Online under A01. You repeat this process until you run out of CD's or storage space.

Once you have completed this, click the column header of Artist/Author on Discware Online, and it will sort your CD's alphabetically. If your Artist is sorted, it makes for a quick reference to find your CDs. Don't worry if the numbers aren't in any order.

Here's why:

If you had your discs arranged in actual alphabetical order inside of your units:

01 - Abba
02 - Beatles
03 - Cars
04 - Depeche Mode
.
87 - Zogart Symphony

If you had a new CD, by the artist "Barn Orchestra" you would have to physically move every disc you had from slot 02, down one. This is not the way we intended the units to be used. Instead, if you place them in any order inside of your units, and created alphabetized titlesheets..

01 - Abba
88 - Barn Orchestra
02 - Beatles
03 - Cars

This is how your titlesheets would look. The alphabetized list makes it easy to find your CD's, and all you have to do is move your Selector knob down to the appropriate number to get it! That way, if you add a new CD, you can add it to the last slot, and all you would have to do is create a new titlesheet!

You will now be on your titlesheet set-up page. If you have a Selector 100, your storage unit has 3 titlesheets, Tab A, B, and C. Tab A will print your titlesheet with all 100 discs. Tab B and C show the first and last 50 discs.

Titlesheet Setup

Click the **display titlesheet** button to display the titlesheet. After the titlesheet appears, click the **Print** icon. This will open the **Print** dialog box. Just make sure **fit to page** (Acrobat 4) or **shrink oversized pages to paper size** and **expand smaller pages to paper size** (Acrobat 5) are unchecked and click **OK** to print.

****TROUBLESHOOTING****

if “Now Loading...” window does not appear when you click (or if it does nothing after 10 minutes) please check to see that you do not have any programs running that block the use of pop-up windows. These include, but are not limited to, anti-viral program (i.e. Norton), firewalls (i.e. ZoneAlarm), and integrated browsers (i.e. AOL Internet Explorer).



If you are unable to **add** a new disc:

1. Disable any anti-viral programs you have like Zone Alarm Pro, or Norton Anti-Virus while visiting Discware Online. These programs hinders full use of our website because your computer believes something malicious might be happening. The same goes for any pop-up killers you might have integrated into your browser.
2. Using integrated browsers, like AOL Internet Explorer, may cause some problems while visiting our site. Try using Microsoft Internet Explorer or Netscape. Netscape Navigator handles JavaScript on our website better than MS Explorer.
3. If you've used our web page before, more than likely something that you have installed since your last use is blocking JavaScript. Try to examine everything you may have installed since your last use of the site.
4. Please make sure that you computer is JavaScript and cookie enabled.
In Internet Explorer, go to Tools > Internet Options > Security > Custom Level > Script > Active Scripting (Enable)
In Internet Explorer, go to Tools > Options > Security > Customize and Enable all cookies.
5. Update your operating system. This function is usually found in Windows by clicking 'Start'. If you have a Mac OS, run software updater.
6. If you use WindowsXP Pro, try removing Windows Media Player Bonus Pack with Movie Maker and Journal, along with media library (all downloaded from Microsoft's update page).
